Did you know that

- The Oktoberfest is the world's biggest folks festival, celebrated annually in Munich by about 7 million people?
- Beer consumption over the 17 days equals about 2 million gallons? The beer you drink at the Wiesn is not called "Bier", it is Oktoberfestbier after all.
- The Oktoberfest started out in 1810 as the wedding celebration for the future king of Bavaria?
- The original Oktoberfest did not feature beer vendors until 1819? Serving beer was almost a necessity because Southern Bavaria was once notorious for its awful fresh water supply.
- The Mayor of Munich has the honor of tapping the first keg of Oktoberfest beer?
- Only beer from the six breweries in Munich (Augustiner, Paulaner, Hacker-Pschorr, Spaten, Löwenbräu and Hofbräu) can be served in the 13 huge beer drinking tents?
- Paris Hilton has been permanently banished in 2006 for unauthorized promotion of canned wine?
