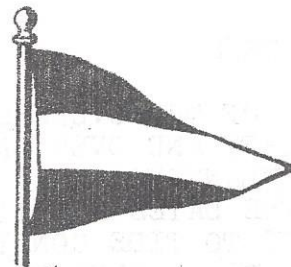

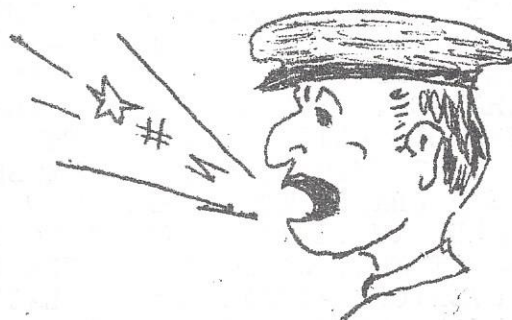
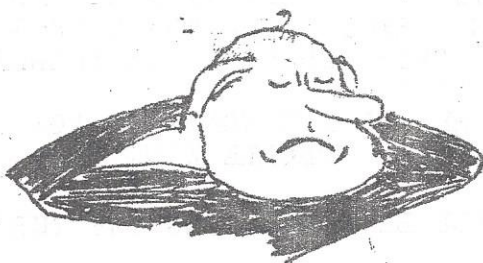

MEXISTEW

1TBSP. BUTTER OR MARGARINE
1TBSP INSTANT ONION FLAKES
2(12oz)CANS ROAST BEEF INGRAVY
1 OR 2 CANS WHOLE KERNEL CORN WITH PEPPERS
CORN CHIPS

COMBINE ALL INGREDIENTS EXCEPT CORN AND CORN CHIPS OVER MEDIUM HEAT.
ADD SALT TO TASTE IF NECESSARY. ADD CORN (DRAINED) AND SIMMER 5-10 MINUTES.
PUT A SMALL MOUND OF CORN CHIPS IN BOTTOMS OF INDIVIDUAL SERVING BOWLS.
POUR STEW OVER. ACCOMPANU WITH FRUIT Or AVOCADO SALAD. SERVES 4-6

VARIATIONS:

ADD CHOPPED STUFFED GREEN OR RIPE BLACK OLIVES TO STEW WHILE HEATING,
GARNISH WITH COARSELY GRATED CHEDDAR CHEESE.

ON BOAT.

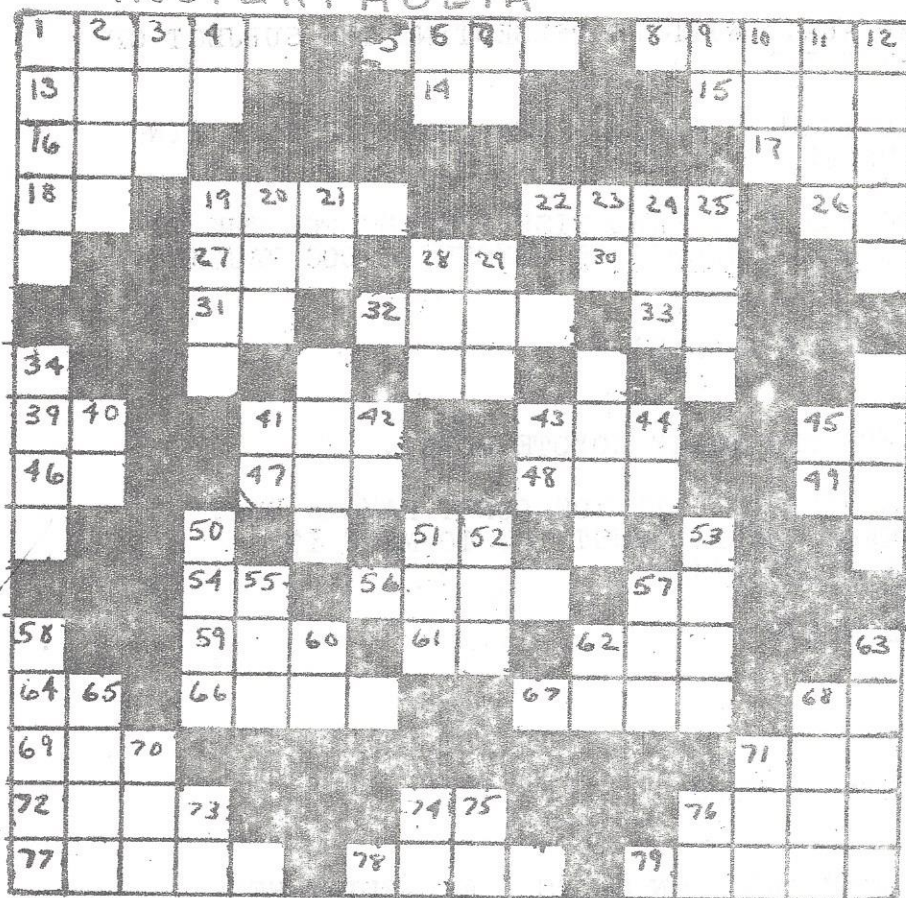

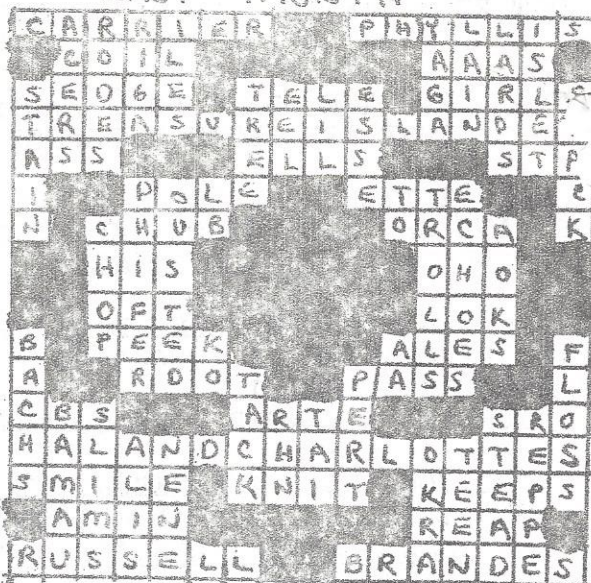
