worth your while to drop by. This is what the club has to offer:

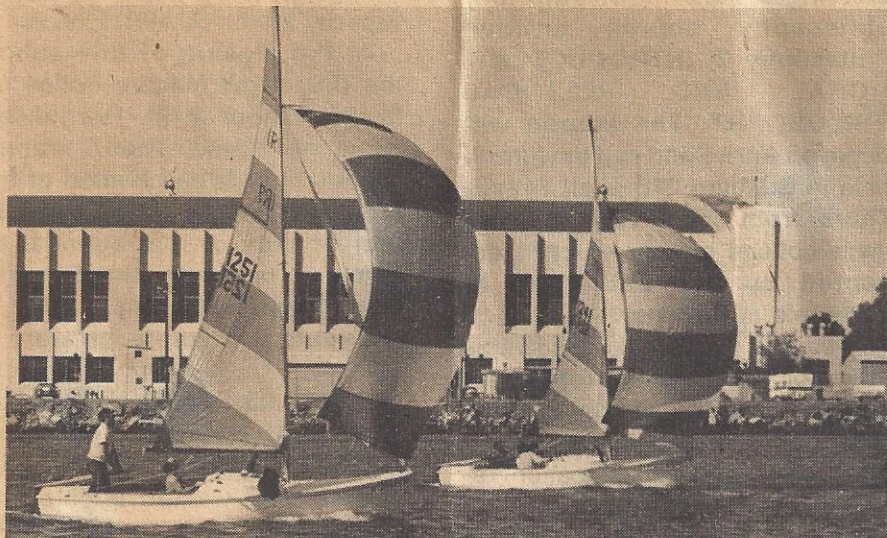
- Racing - monthly club races and participation in the SYRA summer and winter series on SF Bay
